### MY HOMELAND, MY HOMELAND - SPECIAL PRIZE

- Given to the best performer of a song or an aria by a Hungarian composer (works of Liszt, Erkel, Hubay, Bartók, Kodály, Dohnányi or composers from the 20th century and contemporary Hungarian artists)

#### Further rules:

- repertoire must be sung by heart in original key and in original language
- songs can be performed in original key or in published transpositions
- pieces cannot be repeated through rounds
- jury is intended to listen to the entire program in all rounds and in all age groups, but reserve the right to shorten the program if it is necessary
