



BIP "Orchestral meeting: Sound Dialogues between German Romanticism and Spanish Neoclassicism"

February 2026

Throughout the week, participants will take part in orchestral and sectional rehearsals, training sessions led by the Conservatory's faculty, and a cultural visit designed to explore the artistic and historical heritage of the province of Jaén. The project will culminate in two symphonic concerts: the first in the auditorium of the new Conservatory, and the second in one of the most emblematic auditoriums of the province, offering students the opportunity to experience the full orchestral process, from preparation and rehearsal to public performance.

The concert program presents a journey through contrasting European soundscapes: from the dramatic tension of Beethoven's *Coriolan Overture*, through the refined neoclassical elegance of Rodrigo's *Fantasia for a Gentleman*, to the powerful emotional depth of Brahms's *Symphony No. 1 in C minor, Op. 68*. Together, these works illustrate the dialogue between German Romanticism and Spanish Neoclassicism that inspires the project's artistic theme.

The artistic work will be conducted by Antonio Ariza, together with the Conservatory's teaching staff, who will guide students through the technical and musical preparation of the orchestral repertoire. This collaborative approach promotes shared learning, ensemble awareness, and a deeper understanding of European musical and cultural values.
