Children, irrespective of nationality, are invited to take part.

- b. 2 stylistically different pieces

Section A (2 rounds) – categories I, II and III

First round (eliminary)

- a. A study at your will
- b. A piece by Johann Sebastian Bach

Second round

- a. one classical work (Ist part of a Sonata or Sonatine, variations theme)
- b. A Romantic, Modern or Romanian piece at your will

Section B (2 rounds) – categories IV,V and VI

First round (eliminary)

- a. A study at your will
- b. A piece by Johann Sebastian Bach

Second round

- a. A classical sonata, the first part or a musical theme with variations
- b. A Romantic, Modern or Romanian piece at your will

Section C (one round) – ensemble at four hands

For all categories 2 stylistically different pieces

Section D (one round) – chamber music (all instruments)

For all categories 2 stylistically different pieces

between **1st and 31st May 2021** in order to carry out the contest planning.

The ONLINE registration file must contain:

1. Registration form
2. Birth certificate - copy
3. Payment receipt
4. GDPR Consent

Recordings for both rounds will be uploaded in the registration form. The recording will consist of an individual file for each round.

Formal dress code is mandatory!

The recording must allow a clear view of the competitor's hands and face.

The recording will be named like: **participants Name&Surname – Section – Round.**

For better quality of the sound we recommend that the performance be recorded on a classical piano.

Competitors will attach in the registration form a representative photo of themselves.

The registration in the contest implies the agreement of the participants on the eventual recordings or transmissions, without remuneration.

The registration fee for the section A will be in amount of 50 Euros and for section B will be in amount of 60 Euros. The money will be paid in Lei at the exchange rate from that particular day. For section C (ensemble at four hands) and section D (chamber music) the registration fee will be in the amount of 30 Euros in Lei for every participant.

The fee (payable in Lei at the exchange announced by The Romanian National Bank during the payment day) will be put into the banking account opened at the Banca Transilvania– Moșilor branch,
